ORDINANCE NO. 081021B

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEATH, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES IN TITLE XV IN CHAPTER 153 TO ADD SECTION 153.122 EXTENDING THE PROVISIONS OF THE 2006 INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE, THE 2005 NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE, THE 2006 INTERNATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE, THE 2006 INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE, THE 2006 INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE, THE 2006 INTERNATIONAL RESIDENTIAL CODE, THE 2006 INTERNATIONAL MECHANICAL CODE, THE 2006 INTERNATIONAL PLUMBING CODE AND ALL FUTURE AMENDMENTS AND REVISIONS RELATED TO SAID CODES TO THE CITY'S EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION; PROVIDING A PENALTY OF AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF \$2000; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEATH, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the provisions of the 2006 International Building Code, as contained in Section 153.001 and Section 153.002 of the Code of Ordinances, are hereby extended so as to apply to buildings and/or structures within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ).

Section 2. That the provisions of the 2005 National Electric Code as contained in Section 153.010 and Section 153.011 of the Code of Ordinances, are hereby extended so as to apply to buildings and/or structures within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ).

Section 3. That the provisions of the 2006 International Energy Conservation Code, as contained in Section 153.026 and Section 153.026 of the Code of Ordinances, are hereby extended so as to apply to buildings and/or structures within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ).

Section 4. That the provisions of the 2006 International Fire Code, as contained in Section 153.035, Section 153.036 and Section 153.037 of the Code of Ordinances, are hereby extended so as to apply to buildings and/or structures within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ).

Section 5. That the provisions of the 2006 International Fuel Gas Code, as contained in Section 153.050 and Section 153.051 of the Code of Ordinances, are hereby extended so as to apply to buildings and/or structures within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ).

Section 6. That the provisions of the 2006 International Residential Code, as contained in Section 153.080 and Section 153.081 of the Code of Ordinances, are hereby extended so as to apply to buildings and/or structures within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ).

Section 7. That the provisions of the 2006 International Mechanical Code, as contained in Section 153.095 and Section 153.096 of the Code of Ordinances, are hereby extended so as to apply to buildings and/or structures within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ).

Section 8. That the provisions of the 2006 International Plumbing Code, as contained in Section 153.120 and Section 153.121 of the Code of Ordinances, are hereby extended so as to apply to buildings and/or structures within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ).

Section 9. Any future amendments or revised editions to the codes as listed in Sections 1 through 8 above shall also be considered to be applicable to the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ).

Section 10. That any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction, be subject to a fine in an amount not to exceed \$2000.

Section 11. That if any paragraph, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding of invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 12. That this Ordinance shall be effective from and after its adoption, and it is so ordained.
