

**CITY OF HEATH
ORDINANCE NO. 081021A**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCE IN TITLE III, ADMINISTRATION, CHAPTER 33, CITY ORGANIZATION, SECTION 33.25, INTERFERENCE IN DISCHARGE OF DUTIES, TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO INTERFERE WITH DISCHARGE OF DUTIES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS PROVIDING OF A FINE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF \$500; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEATH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Heath Code of Ordinances shall be amended in Title III, Chapter 33, Section 33.25 to read as follows:

“§ 33.25 INTERFERENCE IN DISCHARGE OF DEPARTMENTAL DUTIES.

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to interfere with, or in any manner, hinder any members or employee of the Department of Public Safety, Code Enforcement Officer, Building Official, Animal Control, Fire Marshal or any other employee in the discharge of their duties.”

SECTION 2. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is illegal, invalid, or unenforceable under present or future laws, the remainder of this Ordinance will not be affected and, in lieu of each illegal, invalid, or unenforceable provision, a provision as similar in terms to the illegal, invalid, or unenforceable provision as is possible and is legal, valid, and enforceable will be added to this Ordinance.


SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance will take effect upon its adoption by the City Council and publication of the caption hereof.
