PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE

The City of Heath continues to work with the consulting firm of Kimley-Horn to develop a design for the Heath Towne Center, also known as the Towne Center Overlay District, and a design for Towne Center Park. A final Towne Center Park concept plan has been approved by the Park Board and the Heath Economic Development Corporation/Heath Municipal Benefits Corporation (HEDC/HMBC), which dedicates 25% of its annual revenue to park and community improvement investments. City Council will discuss and take action on the plan at its August 24 meeting. You can keep up to date on these important initiatives at DesignHTC.com or by scanning the QR code.

PROTECTING SENSITIVE CUSTOMER INFORMATION

In an effort to protect sensitive customer information from predatory practices, the Texas State Legislature passed H.B. 872 that applies to information held by the City relating to water, wastewater, sewer, gas, garbage, electricity, or drainage service. Effective immediately, the City of Heath cannot disclose information relating to customer accounts including address, usage and disconnections. You may request the City to release this information in response to a public information request by filling out the Utility Disclosure Form, which can be found at heathtx.com under the Utility Services page.
